WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

- PROBAN® clothing can be washed in a conventional washing machine
- We recommend washing PROBAN® protective clothing at temperatures of up to 60°C
- Heavily stained articles can be pre-soaked (up to two hours at room temperature) in an enzymatic-type detergent if desired
- PROBAN® clothing can be ironed once washed and dried
- Users should ensure these general guidelines are considered in conjunction with manufacturer care instructions supplied with the protective clothing

LIMITATIONS OF USE

- Wearer must complete a risk assessment to determine suitable protection required
- Risk assessment must determine if the garment is suitable for known application/risk
- Replace garment when visual signs of wear and tear

STORAGE & SHELF LIFE

- Store the jacket in a dry, cool place when not in use
- Avoid hanging the jacket in direct sunlight or storing it in damp conditions, as this can cause the leather to deteriorate



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
